- 7.0 - 8.0 Mare is not ready. It could be a few weeks
 - 6.8 Mare is getting close. Foaling could occur any day - test 2 x day.
 - 6.4 Watch mare closely. She is progressing and can change quickly.
 - 6.0 Foaling should occur within 12 hours. The more yellow the strip - the closer she is.
- *these are guidelines - foaling patterns vary.

FOALING NOTES

GUIDE

Behaviors: where they like to stand in the stall, how they sleep, how loose the tail is, how they are eating

Milk pH range: pulling milk daily to check range, milk consistency and color

Udder: are you able to get milk at all, waxing
